The “Boating Skills & Seamanship” course was developed by the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary to give recreational boaters the knowledge and understanding they need to cope with almost any situation found on the water. Course subjects include nautical language, types of boats, powerboat handling, safety and legal requirements, navigation rules, aids to navigation (ATON’s), trailering, marine engines, marlinspike (knot tying), VHF marine radio, inland boating, weather, and many other topics of interest to the recreational boater. The information covered is designed to awaken new safety awareness and provide for greater proficiency in your boating experience. Instructors are members of the **Cary Flotilla** of the **United States Coast Guard Auxiliary**.
